## 1st case - Employment programme for youth in the municipality

2nd case - Business idea contest «Be entrepreneur!»



- First year 🙂
- <u>The aim of the programme</u>: to promote Daugavpils district's youth employment during the summer holidays, making it possible to increase the practical skills, find an understanding of professions and to gain initial practical experience.
- <u>Municipality budget for the programme</u>: 10 000 LVL (salary – municipality, taxes – employer)



- Initial survey 260 interested
- Offered work places more than 120
- Number of applications received 160
- Can finance ~115





- Kinds of works: territory cleanup, weeding, mowing, beekeeping, work in library, work with youth and children, technical works etc.
- Results = 110 employees! ③



- <u>The aim</u>: to give authors of business ideas necessary knowledge, develop skills and motivate them to develop a business idea to a full-fledged business plans that would be implemented in a viable business.
- <u>The target audience</u>: youth or group of youth in the age of 16-30 (not more than 4 people in one team) with a clearly defined business idea.







- 500 LVL I place, 400 LVL II place, 300 LVL I place
- «Be entrepreneur 2011/2012» & «Be entrepreneur 2013»





- 1st stage business idea submission
- 2nd stage practical seminars, trips to enterprises, to business incubator etc.
- 3rd stage business plan submission
- 4th stage business plan presentations





 Practical seminars: «Business Plan Development», «Financial Planning», «Business plan and cash flow form filling», «EU funding and other support opportunities for entrepreneurs», «Cooperation with the bank, the bank offered opportunities», «Company registration, bookkeeping», «Team management», «Presentation skills»









- 2 new companies from 1st contest, 1 author still develops the idea
- seems to be 5 new companies from 2nd contest (2 already)
- motivated youth
- more than 35 youth gained entrepreneurial skills
